- Admissions shall be made on the basis of score/marks obtained in the Common University Entrance
 Test (CUET-PG-2025) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- 2. PROVISIONAL ADMISSION will be offered to the applicants, who have passed first 5 semesters of the qualifying Bachelors Degree Examination (Honours or General)/ 6 Semesters OR any other examination recognised as equivalent thereof, from a recognised university/institution with at least 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) as on the date of admission.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the statutes, a candidate who has appeared or is appearing in the final semester/ year of the qualifying examination and is expecting to pass with the requisite percentage of aggregate marks in the said examination and fulfils the program specific eligibility is eligible to apply. However, the applicants provisionally admitted to the program shall have to submit the result of the final semester/ year of the qualifying examination within 45 days from the date of commencement of their class work.
- 4. Filling up of the Online Admission Form is a pre-requisite for admission. The candidates are required to fill the same carefully as per the statutes.
- Candidates are advised to be in continuous touch with the college website/admission portal for the latest information with respect to admission, eligibility and other details.
- Admission in any PG Course shall be subject to the condition that at least one-third of the seats are

- 1. In case only one seat is available under category 10(a), 10(b) or category 11(a), 11(b) the same shall be filled on basis of comparative merit of all the candidates under these categories put together, as the case may be.
- 2. For determining the number of seats under any reserved category, fraction of less than one half shall be ignored and fraction of one half and more shall be treated as one. The benefit of fraction shall be given to each category separately even if it means an overall marginal increase in seats in any course of study.
- 3. In case any of the seat/s remain vacant in a reserved category (which are convertible) for want of eligible candidates, the same will be offered to the candidates of nonreserved i.e. open merit group.
- 4. Selection of candidates against reserved seats shall be made on the basis of comparative merit in the respective categories, except achievement categories.
- 5.For selection under Achievement category inter-se-merit shall be determined in accordance to the Statue---a) marks/points awarded to such a candidate for these activities, plus b) one fourth (1/4) of the percentage of the CUET Score (CUET-PG-25). The composite score thus calculated, shall form the basis of admission.
- 6. To be a beneficiary of reservation, the candidate must be a permanent resident / domicile of J&K UT, except when applying under categories 10(a) and 10(b) i.e. Sports/cultural and Literary activities and 11(a) and 11(b), i.e. NCC/NSS/Bharat Scouts and Guides activities for which he/she must have passed the qualifying examination from University of Jammu or from any recognized university within the Jammu province.
